2017 Exercise Unified Control - Highlights

- Two day inter-operability exercise Dec. 6&7, 2017
 - Day 1 focused on on-site response
 - Day 2 focused on off-site response
- The scenario will be a "Severe Accident" at Pickering Nuclear
 - > Will result in deployment of Emergency Mitigating Equipment
 - Will exercise public protective action decision making
- 34+ agencies are participating from the municipal, provincial and federal authorities
- New technology is being demonstrated:
 - Data transfer from OPG to CNSC
 - Unified Rascal Interface (URI) dose projection software
 - ➤ P-25 radios





Emergency Mitigating Equipment at Pickering


- Portable pumps and generators are available for each unit and the used fuel bays (including spares)
- Stored on site at PNGS outside the protected zone
- Each pump and generator is ready for deployment at all times:
 - Trailer mounted and secured
 - Daily, monthly and yearly checks performed
