PWMF Licence Renewal Scope



Aerial view of OPG's Pickering Waste Management Facility

- Application to renew licence to August 2028
- Hearing - April 13, 2017
- Planned expansion:
 - 3 additional used fuel dry storage buildings
 - New Dry Storage Container Processing Building
- To accommodate DSCs from Pickering until the end of commercial operation
- Requested end date aligns with station application end date



PWMF Licence Renewal Hearing

Hearing Focus Areas

- Understanding timing of the Application
- Discussion regarding terms for Environment reporting, control levels
- Availability of the Environmental documentation, connection with PNGS



PWMF Licence Renewal Status

- OPG is awaiting a decision by the Commission, but expect to receive the renewed licence well before expiry
- Commission requested OPG provide additional information post-Hearing – provided
- Any other actions would be specified by Commission
- Will not impact construction of Storage Building #4 (allowed under current licence), or the Processing Building
