Ontario Power Generation (OPG) operates a diversified portfolio comprising numerous generating stations: two nuclear (Darlington and Pickering), 66 hydroelectric, three thermal and one wind turbine. Through these facilities, OPG generates clean, reliable and low-cost energy, delivering about 50 per cent of Ontario's electricity. More than 99 per cent of this power is free of smog and carbon emissions. OPG's electricity is priced 40 per cent lower than other generators, which helps moderate customer bills.
