The purpose of this letter is to notify the CNSC that OPG is seeking an early renewal of the Darlington New Nuclear Project (DNNP) Power Reactor Site Preparation Licence (PRSL) 18.00/2022. The licence expires on August 17, 2022. OPG understands the normal expectation is to submit a licence renewal application at least 12 months before the licence expiry date.

OPG intends to file an application no later than August 17, 2020, instead of August 17, 2021, as previously notified (Reference 1). OPG's decision to seek early renewal of the PRSL is to minimize the risk of the licence expiring and to preserve, for both OPG and our shareholder, maximum flexibility for future nuclear generation at Darlington. In that regard, OPG is seeking a Commission Hearing and decision by Q3 2021.

As suggested by CNSC staff in Reference 2, OPG met with CNSC staff on February 26, 2019 to explore the required information and submission timelines to support the above mentioned application.

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OPG will provide CNSC staff with a Licence Renewal Plan document by June 30, 2019, as committed in the Summary Table. The Licence Renewal Plan document will outline the scope of OPG's site preparation licence renewal activities for DNNP, the methodology to demonstrate the current licensing basis remains valid, and the schedule associated with key licence renewal submissions.
