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INCENTIVE REGULATION

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1.0 PURPOSE

This evidence presents OPG's work plan for an independent productivity study along with a status report.

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2.0 OVERVIEW

- 8 On March 28, 2013, the OEB issued its EB-2012-0340 Report of the Board on Incentive
- 9 Rate-making for Ontario Power Generation's Prescribed Assets (the "Report"). This Report
- sets out the Board's expectations regarding incentive regulation ("IR") for OPG's prescribed
- generation assets, and identifies some next steps for developing an IR regime¹.

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- 13 The Report indicates that after this proceeding is concluded, the Board intends to strike a
- working group to develop recommendations on the details of the IR mechanism for OPG's
- 15 hydroelectric assets². OPG expects the working group will provide recommendations on both
- 16 the IR mechanism and on its implementation, including selection of the base rates to be used
- 17 in the mechanism. A second working group is to develop a proposed methodology for setting
- OPG's nuclear payment amounts based on a multi-year cost of service approach³.

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- 20 The Report also requires OPG to file a proposed work plan and status report for the
- 21 independent productivity study with its next application to set payment amounts⁴, which OPG
- has provided below.

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3.0 PRODUCTIVITY STUDY

25 **3.1 Work Plan**

- OPG has engaged a consultant, London Economics International ("LEI"), to provide advice
- 27 and assistance on potential incentive regulation mechanisms which may be suitable for
- 28 setting payment amounts for OPG's prescribed facilities. LEI participated in the Board's

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- 1 consultation on Incentive Rate Making Options for OPG's Prescribed Generation on August
- 2 29, 2012, presenting its views on potential IR options for OPG's prescribed assets. Given this
- 3 history, OPG has asked LEI to conduct the independent productivity study requested by the
- 4 Board.

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- 6 In April, 2013 OPG asked LEI to provide it with a work plan for an independent productivity
- 7 study to be completed in time to support the working group.

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- 9 LEI submitted a work plan in May, 2013. OPG approved LEI's proposed work plan, provided
- in Attachment 1.

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3.2 Status Report

- 13 As contemplated in the attached work plan, LEI has commenced its literature review and
- begun to identify the challenges associated with conducting a productivity study for OPG's
- prescribed hydroelectric facilities.
