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10 **Response**

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12 OPG management attended a meeting with the Minister of Energy and representatives
13 of the City of Cornwall on December 22nd, 2005 to discuss the issue of property taxes
14 related to the R.H. Saunders Generating Station.
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16 At the meeting, Minister Cansfield stated that the property tax issue was the
17 responsibility of the Minister of Finance. A meeting between the City of Cornwall and the
18 Minister of Finance was to be organized early in 2006. OPG did not participate in any
19 further meetings.
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21 The City also requested that OPG review its local land holdings to see if there was land
22 that is surplus to OPG's needs that could be made available for development. Following
23 the meeting, OPG reviewed its holdings and did not identify any land that was surplus to
24 its needs.
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26 There was no discussion at the meeting of the visitors centre at R.H. Saunders GS.
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28 To the best of OPG's knowledge, there was no written correspondence between OPG
29 and the Minister's office on this issue.
